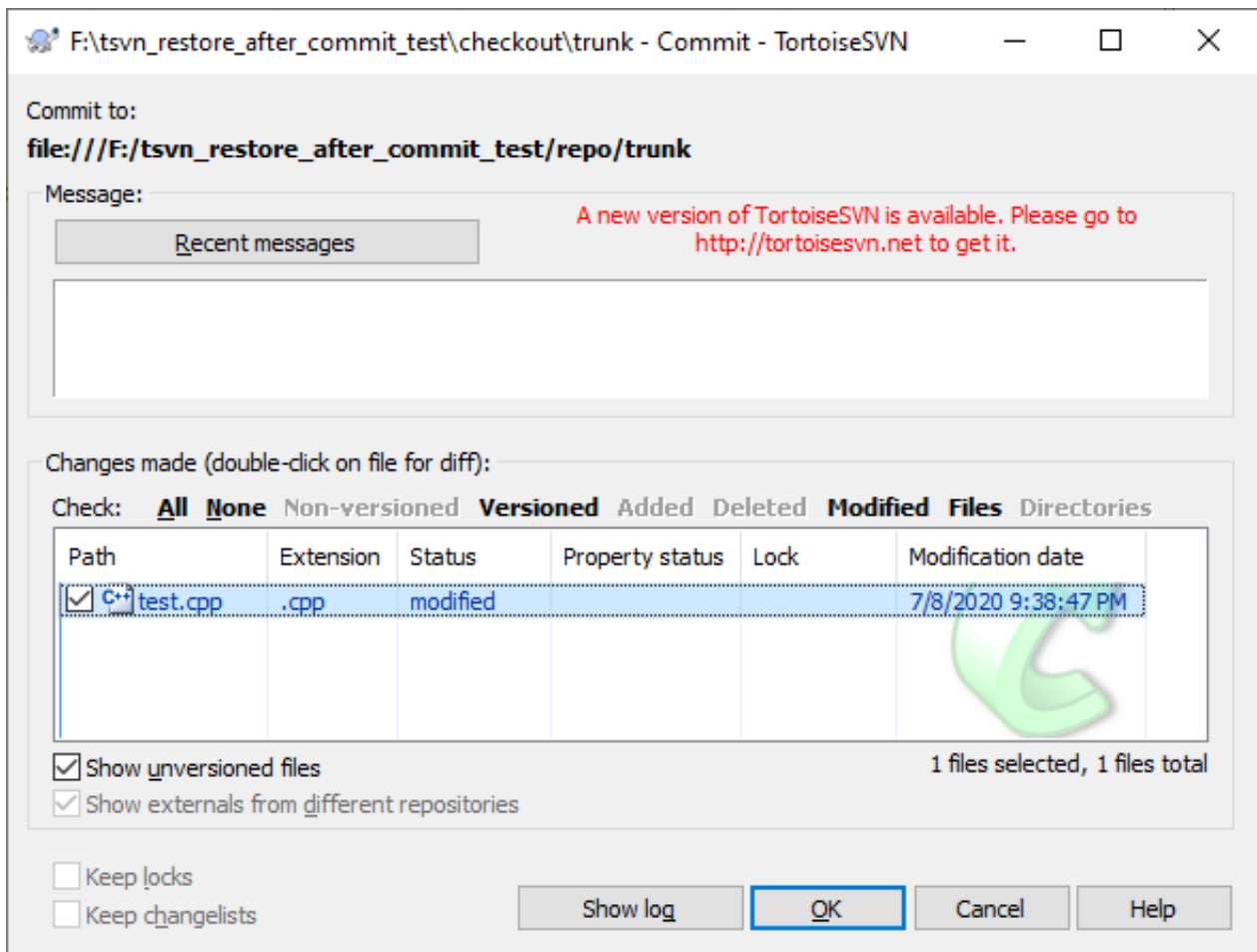

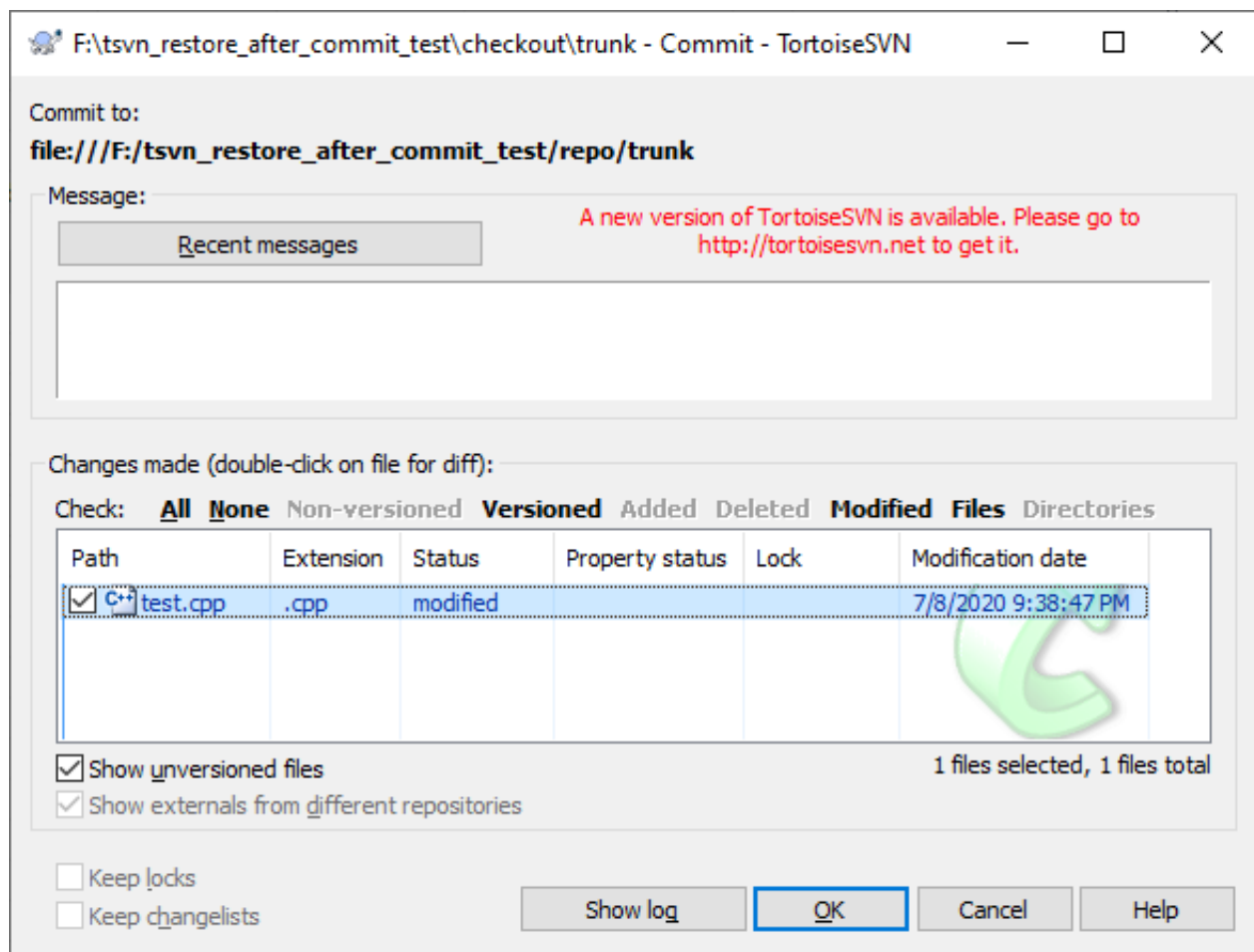

I've never found any, but the solution that I usually use is to simply apply the patch file to a pristine checkout of the tree, and then do a "regular" diff (my preferred tool is diffuse) to review the changes in context.. It is The default patch file viewer is messy (ie no side by side diff view etc).. I tried setting the path of beyondCompare exe in 'Settings->Unified Diff Viewer->custom', but beyond compare also behaves.

In TortoiseSVN you directly create a patch instead of committing your changes and.. you can use Unified-Diff output (GNU patch format) This shows only the differences with a few lines of context.. Updating multiple items is currently not an atomic operation in Subversion So TortoiseSVN first finds the HEAD revision of the repository, and then updates all items to that particular revision number to avoid creating a mixed revision working copy..
